    - For sole proprietors/self-employed: submission of the business licence and proof of operations in 2025, such as a tax return;
- ◆ If the dependent relative is studying, copies of academic transcripts or proof of school attendance covering the period from January to December 2025 must be submitted. 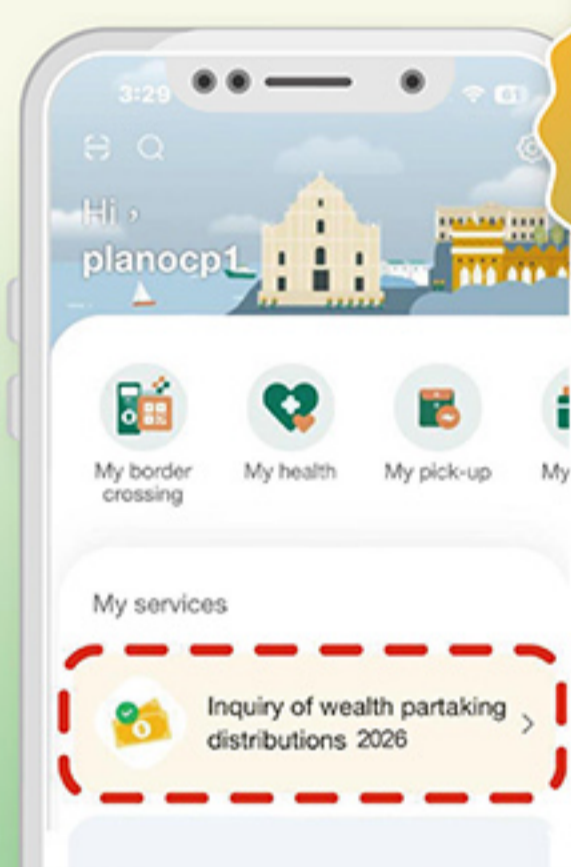

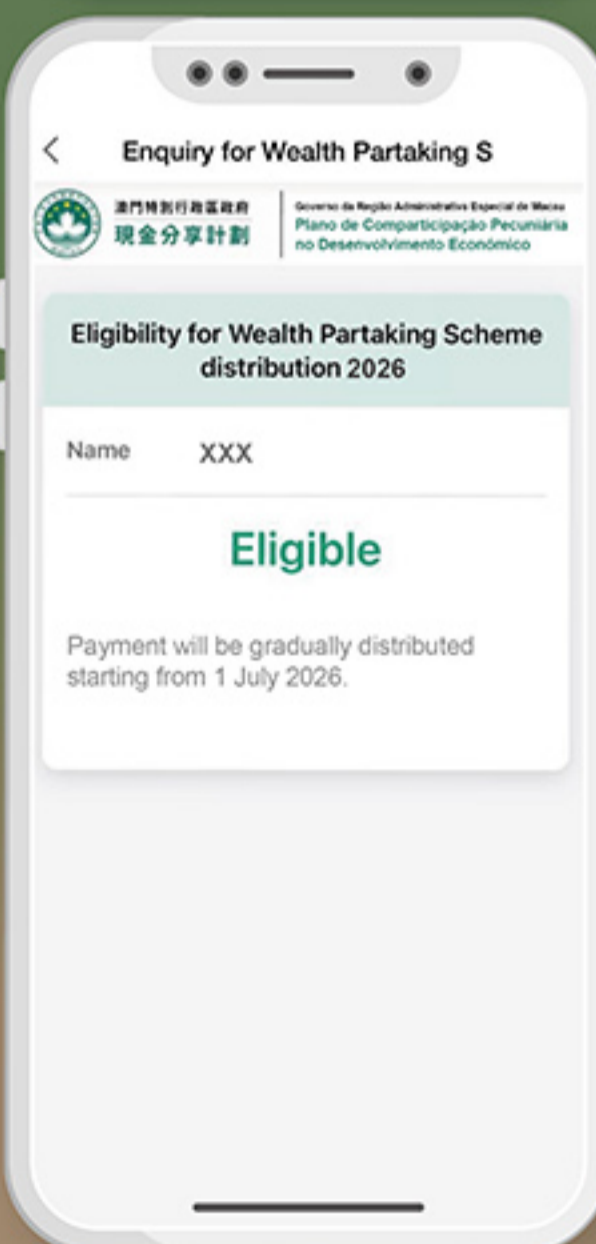


Macao One Account (Simplified Version)

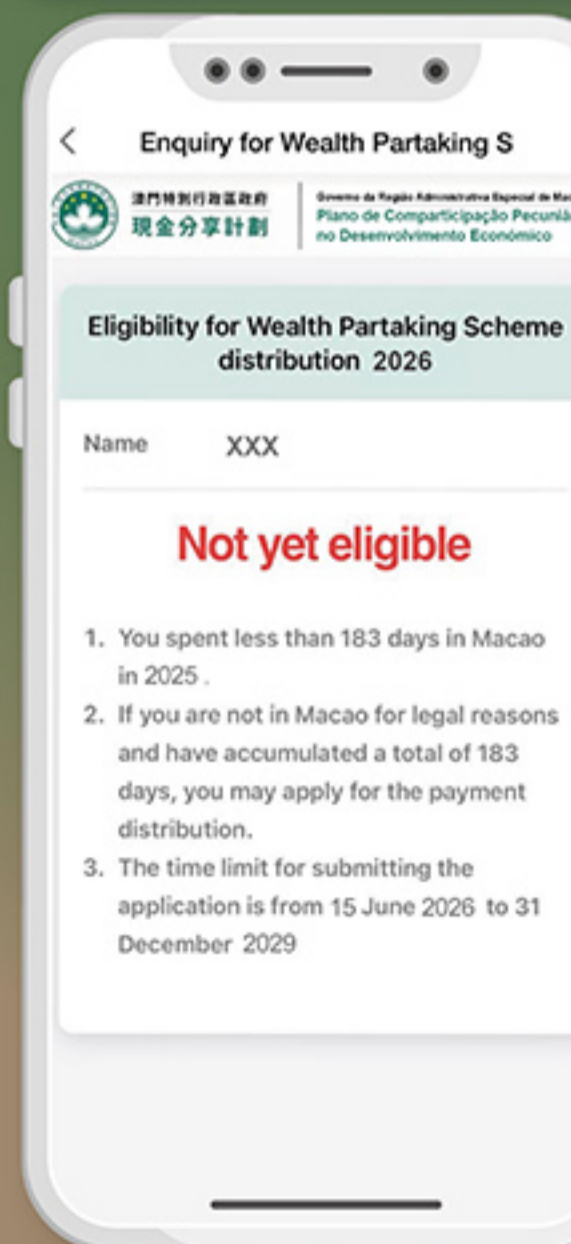
