1. In-Person Submission:

- a. Complete and sign this Statement of Request.
- b. Present the original Macao SAR Resident ID Card.

2. Submitted by a Representative:

- a. The applicant must complete and sign this Statement of Request.
- b. Provide a copy of the Macao SAR Resident ID Card.
- c. Provide proof of being alive (If submitting at the front desk, a copy is acceptable, but the original must be presented for verification. If submitting by mail, the original document is required). Acceptable proof includes a medical certificate, certification issued by a nursing home, or proof issued by a resident committee in the Chinese mainland. (Please note that the supporting document must be issued within the same year as the distribution of funds. The document must include the applicant's name as it appears on the Macao SAR Resident ID Card, as well as the Macao SAR Resident ID Card Number, date of birth, and, if applicable, the date of the medical consultation.)
