



2024 Special Allocation from Budget Surplus

- ♦ The amount allocated is **7,000** patacas
- ♦ To be eligible for fund allocation, the account owner must satisfy the three eligibility requirements below at the same time:
 - He or she was a permanent resident of Macao who attained age 22 in 2023
 - He or she was still alive on 1 January 2024
 - He or she was in Macao for at least 183 days in 2023
- ★ Residents who are eligible for allocation of funds for the first time are entitled to the one-time incentive basic funds of 10,000 patacas at the same time.

Included in the list

Persons included in the list need not go through any formalities





Not included in the list

A person who was in Macao for less than 183 days in 2023 due to a reason below may file an objection statement:

- He or she attended higher level courses recognized by local competent authority
- He or she attained age 65 and habitually resided in mainland China
- He or she worked outside Macao in order to bear the main living expenses of his or her spouse, any degree of lineal consanguinity or affinity who resided in Macao
- (For the above reasons, you may file an objection statement via the Macao One Account)
- 4 He or she was hospitalized
 - He or she under age 65 but habitually resided in mainland China on health grounds, particularly for the need for non-hospital nursing, palliative therapy, rehabilitative services or family care
- He or she worked outside Macao for an employer registered with the Social Security Fund
- He or she performed official duties, performed duties for Macao or discharged other official duties
- He or she had humanitarian or other properly explained reasons
- Prescription for claiming entitlement to allocation of funds for 2024 is 3 years, i.e. the right will expire on 31 December 2027. The right will become invalid after the expiration date.
