2. Relevant supporting documents demonstrating the reasons and necessity for the applicant’s residence in Macao for fewer than 183 days within the twelve months preceding the application (e.g., medical certificates).
3. If applicable, photocopies of the Macao SAR Resident ID Cards of the principal family members residing in Macao, together with documents proving the relationship (for spouses, the marriage date must be shown).
4. Relevant supporting documents demonstrating the applicant’s residence in Macao during the twelve months before remaining outside Macao for the reasons stated in Section II (e.g., employment certificates, academic transcripts).

**Note: For verification and investigation purposes, other supporting documents as required by the Social Security Fund must also be submitted.**
