## DECLARATION

Note 1: Main living expenses: That is, half or more of the relative's living expenses.

Note 2: The dependent relative must have habitually resided in Macao for at least 183 days in the 12 months prior to the application for enrollment in the arbitrary system. According to the law, the Social Security Fund may verify the number of days the dependent relative stayed in Macao through a dedicated department.

Note 3: In the case of in-laws (e.g. parents-in-law), second-degree immediate family (e.g. grandparents, grandchildren), or the children who are working, the supplementary information in point III must be filled in.

Note 4: If the relative whose living expenses were being paid is an underage, here must be signed by his or her guardian and a photocopy of the guardian's identification document must be submitted. If the relative whose living expenses were being paid is incapacitated/has passed away, the relevant documents must be submitted.

**OTHER DOCUMENTS THAT MUST BE SUBMITTED**

1. A photocopy of the declarant's Macao SAR Resident ID Card;
2. If the relative whose living expenses were being paid has passed away, a death certificate must be submitted;
3. The document(s) to prove that the declarant has borne the main living expenses (e.g. the remittance slip of the relevant year, showing the names of the declarant and the relative whose living expenses were being paid). If such proof cannot be provided, two Macao SAR residents must be provided as witnesses, and photocopies of their Macao SAR Resident ID Cards must be submitted;
4. If the child whose main living expenses were being paid was attending school, a photocopy of the proof of school attendance or transcript(s) of the relevant time period must be provided. If the child was attending a high school or university outside Macao, the declarant must also provide a photocopy of the child's transcript(s) or diploma(s) of the junior high school and high school in Macao;
5. If the relative whose main living expenses were being paid was hospitalized outside Macao, please submit the proof of hospitalization.

**NOTE: In addition to the above documents, the declarant must also provide other relevant supporting documents required by the Social Security Fund.**
